Subject: Community District Public Safety Meetings Scheduled

The City is sponsoring a Community Immigration "Know Your Rights" forum for those in the community concerned about and/or potentially impacted by recent changes to Federal immigration laws and enforcement. The forum is being co-sponsored by the South Monterey County Joint Union High School District and will be conducted by Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Monterey.

The forum will take place at the St. John the Baptist Catholic Church Hall, located at 504 N. Third Street, on Sunday, April 2nd, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. It will be presented in both Spanish and English. The purpose of the forum is to help members of the community to be better informed and prepared. It will help participants learn about the latest information, about services available to assist local community members, ways to be prepared, and to understand how the system of government works on immigration and citizenship issues.

The City Council also approved funding for services offered by Catholic Charities in order to make ongoing assistance available during this year. The program is part of an overall effort by the City and the South Monterey Joint Union High School District to be responsive to the needs of the community.
