Subject: **KING CITY STORM RESPONSE**

King City Public Works staff responded at 10:00 p.m. Sunday, January 22nd through 3:00 a.m. Monday January 23rd in response to water on Villa Drive when San Lorenzo Creek breeched its banks due to the storm. Pumps were delivered and operated by the crew, which helped to avoid any damage from occurring.

According to City Manager Steve Adams, the City was also assisted by sandbags that were installed along the creek bank last year through a community volunteer project. "Even though the benefit came a year after we anticipated, the work of our community volunteers had a significant impact in minimizing flood waters from entering the neighborhood, so this is a great example of our community making a difference." All the sandbags from last year's project were left in place in case of potential storm activity this year.

Sand and sandbags remain available at the Fire Station for residents in need of them for any future storm activity this season. Arrangements for sandbag pickup must be made by contacting the non-emergency dispatch number at 831-385-8311.
