Subject: New King City Street Sweeper Dedication

Everyone is invited to join City officials for a dedication and viewing of the City's new street sweeper on Tuesday, April 9th at 5:30 p.m. in front of City Hall, 212 S. Vanderhurst Avenue. The City recently purchased the new Elgin Pelican Street Sweeper for approximately \$230,000, which was delivered last week. The new equipment will enable the City to enhance its efforts to beautify streets throughout the community, as well as remove leaves to maintain appropriate drainage through the rainy seasons. The new street sweeper includes a number of new features that will enhance service, and the model was specifically selected to enable sharp turns in order to sweep around parked cars and obstacles the City's street maintenance worker must maneuver.

One of the City's two existing street sweepers is no longer operational. The other one is also beyond its anticipated life span and has been unreliable. It will be maintained as backup equipment.
