On November 4th and 12th, 2015, all schools in the King City Union School District were closed due to bomb threats coming into the 9-1-1 Communications Center. These closures were done out of an abundance of caution on the part of the school district. The schools were protected and searched by the King City Police Department with the assistance of the California Highway Patrol and a reserve officer with a bomb detection dog from the Del Rey Oaks Police Department. No devices or anything out of the ordinary were found. The King City Police Department took these threats to the safety of our schools and children very seriously and has been following up on all leads as well as enlisting the help of experts to identify the caller and the phone used. To that end, we are releasing the audio of one of the 9-1-1 calls.
