TYPE OF INCIDENT: Assault on King City Officers and MCSO Deputies

On 08/23/15, at approximately 11:37 p.m., King City Police was on routine patrol in the 500 block of Canal Street. The officer observed William Tallman (46 years old) pick up and turn over a large cement trash receptacle and throwing garbage all around the business area.

The officer attempted to make contact with Tallman, who immediately began to physically attack the officer. The Monterey County Sheriff's Department responded to assist and Tallman continued to fight with the officers and the deputies. During the altercation, Monterey County Sheriff's Canine was utilized in the apprehension of Tallman.

During the incident, one King City Police Department officer and one Monterey County Sheriff Department deputy were injured. The officer and deputy were treated at Mee Memorial Hospital and later released. Tallman was transported to County Jail with several charges including vandalism, battery and resisting arrest.
