On 11/14/15 at 8:48 pm, King City Police Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of N. Second Street, regarding a theft of a vehicle which had just occurred. Witnesses advised the vehicle was last seen traveling at a high rate of speed on Second Street. During the ongoing investigations Monterey County Sheriff's Deputies assisted and located the vehicle. The collaborative efforts of the King City Police and Monterey County Sheriff's Deputies resulted in three suspects taken into custody and the recovery of the stolen vehicle.

Carolina Aparicio Ramirez (18 years), Jesus Alberto Bautista (18 years), and Pedro Casas (21 years) from King City CA, were all booked and later lodged into the Monterey County Jail for Vehicle Theft, Possession of Burglary Tools, Burglary, Hit and Run, Driving without a license, Criminal Conspiracy, Possession of a Controlled substance, Providing a fake name and gang enhancements.
