

On 05/08/16 at 1:26 pm, King City Police Officers were dispatched to the 600 block of Reich St. for a structure fire involving a single level residence. KCPD officers evacuated and assisted the tenants to safety. The King City Fire Department extinguished the blaze. King City Fire was also assisted by Cal Fire, and SoMoCo Fire Department. PG&E arrived on scene to discontinue electrical service to the downed power lines. Nine tenants were displaced and were later provided assistance by Red Cross. No tenant suffered any injuries. A second residence sustained minor heat and smoke damage.

Antonio Cisneros (27 years old) from King City was subsequently identified as a person allegedly causing the fire. Cisneros was not on scene and is currently outstanding. Cisneros has a tattoo of "Ana" on the right side of his neck and a tattoo of "Rosalinda" behind his right ear. Cisneros was last seen wearing blue jeans and a grey sweater.
