On 01/19/16 at 7:09 pm, a King City Police Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of S. Third St. for a domestic violence incident. The investigation revealed the victim had been stabbed by the mother of his children. The victim was transported to the hospital and treated for injuries. The victim is in stable condition and is expected to survive.

Yesenia Diaz Juarez (24 years) from King City was subsequently taken into custody. Juarez was booked and later lodged into the Monterey County Jail for Attempted Murder, Domestic Violence, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and Child Endangerment
