

Notice of Public Hearing for Submittal of State CDBG Application

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of King will conduct a public hearing on July 12, 2016 at 6:00 pm, at City Council Chambers located at 212 S. Vanderhurst Avenue in King City, in order to consider the submittal of an application in response to the 2016 State Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), and to solicit citizen input.

The City of King City is applying for up to \$2 Million for a grant and the approval to expend up to \$150,000 in anticipated Program Income (if any returned) under this NOFA for the following eligible activities:

- Public Improvement: Sidewalk, curb/gutter project – Up to \$1.5 Million
- Public Facility: Skate Park Renovation – Up to \$300,000
- Public Service: Crime Prevention Program – Up to \$200,000

The purpose of this public hearing is to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known regarding the CDBG application that will be submitted.

The complete meeting agenda and copies of the staff report on the above item will be available to the public at the City Clerk's Office, by July 11, 2016 no later than 12 Noon.
