Suspect Vehicle: Newer white Honda or Nissan or similar vehicle, 4 doors with a white and blue license plates occupied by three persons. No further details.

On 10/22/17 at approx. 1707 hours King City Police Department officers were dispatched to the 300 blk of Seventh St. in regards to gunshots being fired from a vehicle. While officers were enroute they were advised of shots being fired in the area of the 600 blk of Luckett as well. Upon the officers arrival they located two vehicles in the 600 blk of Luckett which were unoccupied that had been struck by several rounds of the gunfire. Upon further inspection of the area a residence in the 300 blk of Seventh Street had also been struck by the gunfire. There were no injuries reported. The officers located several witnesses who revealed a newer white Honda or Nissan or similar vehicle, 4 doors with a white and blue license plates occupied by at least three persons drove east on Luckett Ave from Seventh St. when a passenger began firing handgun out the window, striking the two listed vehicle and the side of the residence. Several spent shell casings were located on the street and bullet strikes to the vehicles and residence were located. The suspect vehicle went south on S. San Lorenzo and east on Division out of view.

Due to the nature of the crime, it is being investigated as a possible gang related crime at this time.

The King City Police Department is currently investigating this case. No other information is being released at this time.
