TYPE OF INCIDENT: Assault with a Deadly Weapon – Non Firearm / Brandishing a Replica Firearm

SUSPECT: MALE JUVENILE, 16 YEARS OLD, KING CITY

On 08-26-17 at 18:34 p.m., King City Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a brandishing of a firearm, in the 400 block of North Third Street. Upon arrival officers contacted the victim, who provided a suspect vehicle description of a grey colored van, occupied by numerous juvenile males.

The suspect vehicle was located by officers at Soberanes Street at Meyer Street, where it was stopped and the occupants, six juvenile males were detained. One of the juveniles was found to be concealing a pistol in his pants. The pistol was later determined to be a BB pistol. The victim later identified one of the juvenile males as the subject who brandished and pointed the pistol.

The juvenile male suspect was taken into custody, booked and later transported to the Monterey County Juvenile Hall, where he was booked for 245(a)(1) PC and 417.4 PC. The remaining juvenile males were later released to their parents.
