On July 3, 2017 at approx.. 2130 hours an officer of the King City Police Department was on patrol in the area of the 900 blk of Broadway, when he noticed the doors to the firework stand at that location were open. The officer noticed a subject dressed in dark clothing run from the area of the fireworks stand. While the officer was checking the area, a second subject also dressed in dark colored clothing, ran in another direction away from the area. The officer noted the padlocks to the stands were missing and just outside the stand the officer located a bag of fireworks which was recovered. As other officers arrived a check of the area for the suspects that fled on foot met with negative results. The ensuing investigation determined, person(s) unknown removed the locks to the fireworks stand by unknown means and took an undetermined amount of fireworks from the stand without permission.

The fireworks stand belongs to the King City Chamber of Commerce, who were contacted and they advised once an inventory was conducted a loss would be determined.
