On 10-29-17 at 5:24 p.m., King City Police Officers were dispatched to a report of shots fired in the 100 block of South Second St. Responding officers were advised a single victim suffering from a gunshot wound was still on scene.

Upon officer's arrival the victim was located and identified as a 24 year old male from King City. The victim was transported to an outside area hospital for treatment of a single gunshot wound. The victim is currently listed as being in stable condition.

The suspect vehicle is a white four door, 2007 Dodge Charger with large aftermarket chrome rims. All of the windows on the suspect vehicle are tinted.

On 11/02/12 the King City Police Department executed a search warrant at a residence in the 200 block of N. Third St. in King City, CA. The search warrant lead King City Police officers to the finding of the suspect vehicle. The investigation developed suspect information where the owner of the vehicle was discovered. Juan Carlos Almaraz, the owner of the vehicle was taken into custody without incident and charged with attempted murder, assault with a

firearm on a person and accessory to a felony crime. He was booked at the Monterey County Jail on the listed charges.
