



ITINERANT VENDORS, SOLICITORS & PEDDLERS Municipal Code Chapter 5.34

REQUIREMENTS FOR

ITINERANT VENDORS, SOLICITORS OR PEDDLERS TO OPERATE IN KING CITY:

- ✓ Health Permit from Monterey County at 620 Broadway Street, King City, Ca. Telephone: (831) 386-6899. Health Permit is required when the business involves food products, please contact Health Department for more information.
- ✓ Itinerant Vendor License from City of King
- ✓ Business License from City of King
- ✓ California Seller's Permit from the State Board of Equalization at 950 E. Blanco Road, Suite 202, Salinas, CA 93901. Telephone: (831) 754-4500.
- ✓ Zoning Permit from Community Development Department, if operating on private property as a Fixed Place of Business. Vendors that are not operating on a private property do not need a zoning permit.
- ✓ Licenses Renewed Yearly (Both Business License and Itinerant License)

PERMITTED SPECIAL EVENT LOCATIONS REQUIREMENTS:

Farmer's Market (Wednesdays Only) May – October at 200 Broadway St

1. Approval by Chamber of Commerce
2. Monterey County Health Department
3. City of King Business License

La Cocina Open Air Market (Wednesdays Only) June – October at 815 Broadway St

1. Approval by La Cocina Operators
2. Monterey County Health Department
3. City of King Business License

King City Flea Market (Sundays Only) at 625 Division St

1. Approval by Salinas Valley Fair, Inc.
2. Monterey County Health Department
3. City of King Business License

OPERATING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY

PUBLIC PROPERTY: Operating on Public Streets or Sidewalks

- San Antonio Park Designated Areas:
 - On a first come first serve basis
 - Only permitted within the three (3) designated on-street parking spaces during the noted time limits.
 - All Itinerant Vendors utilizing the designated parking spaces shall comply with the "Itinerant Vendor Rules & Regulations" form. Designations shall be made and posted from time to time by the City Manager per Municipal Code §5.34.115.
- Sidewalks:
 - No person shall place any goods for display, advertisement or sale on any part of a sidewalk per Municipal Code §13.06.020.
- Streets:
 - No person shall stand or park on any street in a commercial zone any truck, trailer, wagon or push cart with fruit, vegetables, ice cream or any other food or food product offered for sale within 300 ft. of any grocery store, convenience store, deli, restaurant or lunch counter per Municipal Code §10.22.050.

PRIVATE PROPERTY: Operating on Private Property

- Zoning Permit Application
 - Only allows for mobile vending carts
 - There is no cost associated with the zoning permit
 - Submit written proof of permission from the property owner
 - Submit project description and hours of operation
 - Location shall also be reviewed & approved by Monterey County Health Department
 - Only Permitted in the following zones:
 - Village Core (VC) Zone District
 - First Street Corridor (FSC) Zone District
- Conditional Use Permit (CUP) Application
 - A CUP requires a minimum of \$850 deposit and requires a public hearing.
 - A CUP may take up to two (2) months or more for processing.
 - Only Permitted Subject to a CUP in the following zone:
 - Village Business (VB) Zone District
- Per Municipal Code §7.12.010 solicitors, peddlers, itinerant merchants, transient vendors not having been requested or invited to do so by owner of occupant of private residence is prohibited, declared a nuisance and punishable as a misdemeanor.

ITINERANT VENDORS

Mobile or temporary stands, portable cart or motor vehicle selling goods or soliciting orders for sale of such goods. Does not include having a fixed location.

SOLICITORS

Any person who goes upon any private residences in the city, not invited by occupant, taking or soliciting orders for sale of goods or services. Not permitted to operate upon any residential premises between sunset and sunrise.

PEDDLERS

Any person who goes upon any private residence in the city, not invited by occupant, carrying or transporting goods and offering for sale. Also includes those who solicit orders and delivers to purchasers. Not allowed between sunset & sunrise.
