Subject: **CITY OF KING APPROVES SPACE FOR YOUTH BOXING PROGRAM**

At their September 27th meeting, the City of King City Council approved funding to convert two racquetball courts at the King City Recreation Center to space for a youth boxing program. The project will provide a permanent area for a boxing ring and training space to be utilized by the King City Boxing Club, who recently lost the commercial space they had been leasing. The program currently provides recreation and mentoring to over 40 King City youth. According to City Manager Steve Adams: "this action is an excellent example of the City's efforts to leverage its resources by partnering with other organizations to increase recreational programs, particularly those serving youth that will be key to our efforts to address youth violence problems in the community."
