Subject: New King City Entrance Sign Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Everyone is invited to join in a ribbon cutting ceremony on Friday, March 23rd at noon to celebrate the completion of the City's new entrance sign and landscaping project at the corner of Broadway Street and San Antonio Drive. The sign is part of a number of community beautification efforts under way and features sculptured replicas of the Pinnacles to graphically portray the City's role as a gateway to Pinnacles National Park. The majority of costs were paid from PG&E mitigation funds and the sale of a portion of the land to the adjacent hotel property owner. The project also includes a drought tolerant demonstration garden, which was funded by California Water Service.
