Subject: District Watch Public Safety Neighborhood Meetings

The "District Watch" program was formed last year to encourage the community to work in partnership with the Police Department and each other to make our neighborhoods safer. City meetings and/or activities are held twice per year and neighborhoods are encouraged to organize other activities on their own throughout the year.

The next series of meetings in each District are scheduled during the next two weeks on April 22nd and April 29th and everyone is encouraged to participate. An update on the City's efforts to end youth violence will be presented by the Police Chief, and officers assigned to each district will discuss plans to work with residents to develop solutions for local neighborhood problems.
