The pre-application meeting helps applicants navigate the development review process and obtain preliminary comments.

- Five (5) Copies of a Detailed Project Description**
- Five (5) Copies of Preliminary Site Plan drawn neatly and accurately prepared, that will enable ready identification and recognition of submitted information showing the following:**
 - The location, exterior boundaries, and dimensions of the entire property that is the subject of the application. The scale of the drawing and a north arrow shall be indicated.
 - The locations, dimensions and use of all existing and proposed structures on the property.
 - The locations and dimensions of existing driveways and parking areas, including type of surfacing materials, parking spaces, impervious surfaces.
 - The locations of all existing landscaping, trees and major shrubs, with specific specifications as to any vegetation to be removed or retained.
 - Project Description to include Design, Architectural Style, Colors and Materials of proposed accessory buildings.
