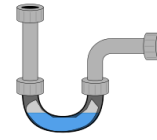


CITY OF KING

HOUSING AND UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



- Description:** The City of King is offering a temporary program providing financial assistance to qualifying households for rent, mortgage and utility costs.
- Dates:** Applications will be accepted beginning on October 15, 2020 until all funding has been committed or expended.
- Covered Costs:** Rent, mortgage payments, water, power, gas, sewer, refuse, power, and cable/internet.
- Eligibility:** The program is primarily for households whose incomes have been impacted by COVID-19. Rental assistance only is available for households behind on rent payments not associate with COVID-19. Applicant's incomes must be below 80% of the County median to qualify. Proof of citizenship is not required. Loss of income due to COVID-19 can be from any time during the pandemic.
- Amounts:** Payments up to \$1,500 per month for 3 months or more depending upon the number of applications received is available for those whose incomes have been impacted by COVID-19. Up to one month rent payment only is available for individuals and households behind on rent payments not associated with COVID-19.
- How to Apply:** Call 2-1-1. You will be asked questions to determine eligibility. Those determined to be potentially eligible will be referred to the City to complete a full application and agreement. Those approved will be required to submit proof from an employer that wages were lost due to COVID-19 and invoices to be paid directly by the City.
- Funding Available:** \$275,000
