7. COUNCIL COMMUNICATIONS:

Mayor Pro Tem Victoria stated he had nothing to report however he has a AMBAG meeting tomorrow. He thanked the staff for putting on the swearing in ceremony of the new Chief of police, two sergeants and two new officers. There have been great improvements to our City.

City Manager Steven Adams stated that the City will be receiving more money about 26% increase. Staff discussed fireworks regulations at staff meeting today. Educating people on the increased fines. For next year the new Chief is looking into using drones. Council chambers are being fitted to be able to virtually share the meetings and have them in person as well with the installation of cameras and speakers. City Manager is hoping at the next meeting to discuss when meetings could be in person again. Restrictions for masks will need to be looked into because OSHA is not dropping their regulations on masks.

City Attorney Roy Santos stated that the fireworks code does not allow people to discharge illegal fireworks so they could be held liable if someone in their residence discharged illegal fireworks.
